The Classic Collection

All our Classic Collection doors have a grained finish and are designed to be stylish, strong and secure. Each door is individually constructed using high impact resistant, Glass Reinforced Polymer (GRP) ². The door is fitted into an insulated PVC-U door frame. To add further strength, security and weather-protection, the GRP skin is bonded to a rigid, water-resistant polymer subframe ⁴ and sealed to a laminate veneer lumber (LVL) inner frame ³. The inner core ¹ is filled with CFC free, high density polyurethane foam for stability and extra insulation. Matching composite side panels are also available in some styles.


Manufactured to provide a secure barrier for your home, all our Classic doors are fitted with a multi-point locking system and an Ultion 3 Star cylinder lock as standard, providing you peace of mind against intruder attack.

To demonstrate energy efficiency all our Classic doors have been independently verified by the British Fenestration Rating Council (BFRC), achieving impressive energy ratings of A+ or B.

The Classic Collection has been designed to be long-lasting, easy to maintain and to provide exceptional weather protection. Available in Traditional, Contemporary and Cottage styles with an array of different colour options to choose from - including the option to have a different colour on the inside. Finish off the look with a stylish range of furniture and glazing options.




The Elite Collection

The Elite Collection of solid core composite doors combines precision-engineering, innovative technology and authentic craftsmanship to provide outstanding results in strength, security and durability.

The cutting-edge combination of materials and security delivers an elite level of performance while maintaining the characteristic look of a high-end hardwood door. Each solid core ¹ door leaf is individually crafted with a low density timber solid core, for improved strength and stability against warping and for added security all are fitted with an Ultion 3 Star cylinder. Durable and highly water resistant, the solid timber core is vacuum moulded on both faces with a thermoplastic skin ³. This skin has a woodgrain effect finish to replicate the appearance of a true timber hardwood door. Our range of solid colours are known as 'through colour', meaning any scratches to the surface will not show a different colour underneath and the insulated five chamber PVC-U frames ⁶ and Q-Lon seal ⁸ provide year-round protection against the elements, giving you a thermally efficient door with a U-Value of 1.4W/m²k.

The Elite Collection's performance is also matched in style. Choose from Traditional, Contemporary and Cottage style designs. There's an array of colour options, available for both sides of your chosen door, and some fantastic finishing touches to complete the look.




Our PVC-U doors come in a range of decorative and energy-efficient insulated panel designs to suit all styles of properties. The door energy ratings are independently verified by the British Fenestration Rating Council (BFRC). The BFRC scheme is Britain's nationally recognised system for rating the energy efficiency of doors and is documented within Building Regulations as a method to show compliance for replacement door installations.

The choice of solid panel, fully glazed or partially glazed doors, make this section ideal for both back and front entrances; and both double and triple glazing options are available in some styles.

Constructed from high impact PVC-U, these doors are strong, durable and virtually maintenance free. A wide range of high performance security features are included as standard, including a multi-point locking system with a Yale 3 Star cylinder offering anti-pick, anti-bump, anti-snap, anti-drill and anti-plug extraction as standard.

All ranges come in a choice of colour finishes* with the option to choose one of our woodgrain finishes on the outside, while keeping a neutral white on the inside. A selection of matching side panels are also available with several of our PVC-U door designs.



Beautiful PVC-U patio and French doors from the Anglian collection are perfect for creating a feeling of spaciousness, letting light and air into your home and bringing you closer to your garden in summer, yet still keeping you warm in winter. They not only add beauty and space but also safety, security and insulation.

Security comes in the form of an anti-jacking device for the patio door and a multi-point locking system for the patio and French doors. They are fitted with Yale anti-snap, anti-bump, anti-pick and anti-drill cylinders and French doors also incorporate two handles with solid aluminium external back plates that resist levering. Highest quality toughened glass sealed units to BSEN12150 are fitted as standard, which increases the resistance to breakage, improving safety, security and insulation.



For extra strength and to prevent warping they are all manufactured using a series of 44mm thick laminated ply layers, with a different grain direction in alternate layers. A thin layer of aluminium is also fitted just below the inside and outside surfaces for improved weather resistance.



Our range of aluminium Bi-Fold doors brings enormous flexibility and a unique sense of spaciousness. Effectively an openable glass wall, Bi-Fold doors are ideal between a conservatory and the rest of the house or between the house and garden. They comprise a number of aluminium door leaves mounted in a mechanically jointed aluminium frame in the same finish. The door leaves can fold inwards or outwards and, with most designs, a primary door (P) that is opened individually can be included.

Double hipped to wall

Creating a grand entrance, the Elizabethan designed double hipped roof really does look appealing particularly if chosen with windows and a door that match the rest of the house.



Single hipped

Making good use of space, the single hipped design attractively complements your home, without dominating the front elevation. This is an ideal style for abutting a garage or gable end.



Double hipped to ridge

A variation on the same double hipped design, the double hipped to ridge porch is an attractive style that is perfect for houses with more space at the front.



Pitched roof

A simple lean to roof with a PVC-U fascia either side, draining to a gutter on the front along with a choice of door with either full height glazing or windows mounted onto a dwarf wall.



Gable end pitched roof

An attractive regency style of porch that can complement any pitched roof house style, especially homes with a gable end roof. The porch's gable end features a PVC-U fascia.



Flat roof

Simply styled flat roofed porches can blend in well with any house design and are ideal if you have a deep window above the front door that could be obscured by a pitched roof or if you live in a bungalow with a low roof line.

Glazing styles

Etched

Etched glass is a range of designs suitable for areas where a degree of privacy is required. The subtlety of etched glass looks understated and offers both contemporary and traditional designs. This glazing style is available in both our double and triple glazed doors.



Etched glass options

One of the first steps in choosing decorative glass is to decide whether you want to enhance the beautiful view outside, or create a stylish way to prevent the outside world from looking in. Before you pick the overall design, select the appropriate obscurity level based on where the glass will be located and what you're looking to achieve.

Ideal for: Windows without views e.g. looking out to a wall or fence.




Silver Mist: The pattern is sandblasted onto Silver Mist glass, to give you full privacy.


Coloured


Fusion


