Our Timber windows

Double-glazed as standard, and available in a wide range of frame options to suit any style of home, our timber windows all retain the aesthetic charms of their forebears while modern manufacturing ensures they are long-lasting and energy efficient. Each window is individually crafted so you can select the finer details to suit your own specific requirements. Choose from a range of frame profile shapes and configuration designs, with the option to add decorative sash horns to all our sliding sash windows.

Flush Finish Casement

For an extremely authentic look, particularly suited to older properties or a contemporary feel to new or refurbished properties, all sashes are designed to sit completely flush with the window frame when shut and are hinged to open outwards, as either top hung or side hung vents. Weatherproofing keeps the draughts out, and the option of restrictor hinges can be selected for modern day safety and security. This window's energy performance achieves an efficient A rated as standard, so you can stay cosy even on the chilliest days.



Stormproof Casement

These windows are designed with performance in mind and are often suited to more contemporary homes. While they sympathetically replicate the look of traditional timber casement windows, the frame is double rebated and the casement stands proud. This creates an overlap when the window is closed which provides additional protection against the weather and helps keep draughts at bay. The windows open outwards as either top hung or side hung vents and achieve an energy efficiency rating of A as standard.



Spiral Balance Sliding Sash

Traditional timber vertically sliding sash windows can date back hundreds of years, but the techniques used to open and close them have evolved. The spiral balanced sliding sash uses a spring-loaded mechanism to counter the weight of the sash, instead of the traditional weights and pulleys. Our Ultralift designs are double sprung for increased efficiency and extra smooth opening and closing. Energy efficiency, A-rated as standard, and with weather seals incorporated both inside and out, these windows don't just look great, they perform brilliantly as well.





Cords & Weights Sliding Sash

These sliding sash windows faithfully replicate the traditional weights and cords opening system which would have been used in the 17th century. The windows slide open vertically within the main frame and are fitted with traditional cords, pulleys and steel weights until the perfect counter balance is achieved for easy operation. The weights and cords system is concealed within the outer frame for a neat, clean look. Energy efficiency, B-rated as standard, these windows provide modern day levels of warmth and comfort.



Tilt & Slide Sliding Sash

The tilt and slide option looks every inch like a traditional, vertical sliding sash window. However, this classic and elegant appearance is combined with a hidden element of modern practicality. Both sashes slide open and shut vertically like a traditional sash window but can also be tilted inwards to make cleaning and maintenance far easier. As with all our timber sash windows, other more modern features can also be added without compromising on design, including lift restrictors for added safety and security and energy efficiency, A-rated as standard.



Bay Windows

Timber bay windows will give your home extra space, enhance your views and allow more light to flood in. Our bay windows can be crafted to your home's specifications from any of the window styles featured, so you can choose your preferred style, function and performance.



Timber window species

Our timber windows are crafted using timber from well-managed, FSC®-certified forests and other controlled sources. The FSC® label means that materials for these products have been responsibly sourced. Look for the FSC® label on our FSC®-certified windows. Our softwood come from cone bearing trees such as pine, whilst hardwood comes from broad leaved trees. The natural, stable nature of hardwood is ideally suited to withstand the weather while all softwood is protected with a double vacuum preservative treatment system.

All our timber window frames come with a 30-year guarantee against rot and fungal attacks*.





Softwood

European Pine

European pine is our standard timber option for windows and is sourced from FSC-certified forests. Look for the FSC® label on our FSC®-certified windows. This softwood species is widely used in external joinery as it is dense, dimensionally stable, almost completely knot free and easy to work with. It is additionally treated with an innovative preservative system to support our 30-year warranty against rot. Available in a painted finish only.



Hardwood

Sapele

Sapele is the preferred hardwood timber option and their trees can grow to be over 45m high which results in exceptionally strong and dense timber which is suitable for exterior joinery without any preservative treatment needed. This hardwood timber is available from well managed sources in West Africa. Available in a painted or stained finish.



Colours to complement

Timber windows are available in an attractive range of expertly applied paint and stain finishes. The microporous paint is added using a 3-coat system to ensure it maintains its elasticity and follows the timber's natural movement helping to prevent cracking or flaking. With our dual option, you can even have different finishes on the inside and outside of the window.







Advanced safety and security features for maximum peace of mind are an integral aspect in the design and construction of every Anglian product. Whichever timber window style you choose we have designed them to withstand forced entry by the opportunist thief with a range of tried and tested, high security features for added peace of mind. If you have any concerns about security or would like further details on our security features and additional options for your chosen window style, just ask us.



The opening vents of our Timber Casement Windows are operated by a key locking handle. They are also fitted with a locking system which clamps to both sides of the striker plates, fitted to the mainframe.



Depending on the Timber Casement Window size, two or three pairs of bi-directional mushroom cams are fitted offering anti-jemmy and anti-separation protection.



Two locking Fitch Catch rotating cam locks are fitted as standard to the top rail of the lower sash on all our Timber Sliding Sash designs.





Our Timber doors

Heritage Timber collection doors are available in a range of solid and partially glazed designs. For extra strength and thermal performance, the 44mm thick door blades are timber faced with an insulated foam core. The timber facings have an aluminium layer placed between them for additional security, stability and weather resistance.

Timber door species

The timber used in our doors is FSC®-certified. Look for the FSC® label on our FSC®-certified doors. By choosing this product you are supporting responsible management of the world's forests. FSC® is a global, non-profit organisation dedicated to the promotion of responsible management of the world's forests.

Our timber door frames are crafted using laminated European Pine (redwood) for painted finishes. This softwood is widely used in external joinery as it is dense, dimensionally stable, almost completely knot free and easy to work with. For stained finishes, a hardwood timber is used. This is a slow-growing timber with a fine, uniform texture.

The door make-up provides excellent thermal performance along with dimensional stability.





helping you feel safe

We understand the importance of feeling safe and secure in your own home, so all our doors come with a wide range of high performance security features as standard. Each door comes factory installed into its rigid door frame, is fitted with robust hinges and has multi-point locking systems, penetrating the frame and locking the door firmly in place in at least three different positions.



- 1. Insulating foam core
- 2. Hardwood timber facings
- 3. Aluminium layers

Hinges

The door leaf is mounted on three hardened steel plated hinges. This robust construction provides enhanced security performance capable of resisting prolonged attacks.

For extra strength

Timber door leaves are timber faced with an insulating foam core. The facings are layers of hardwood timber with two aluminium layers between for additional security and stability.

Locking

Single timber doors are fitted with a Yale Lockmaster multi-point locking system with 2 hooks, centre deadbolt and a Yale 3 star locking cylinder. Double doors use a lever operated mechanism incorporating two heavy duty brass hooks, latch and deadbolt with two shoot bolts on the slave leaf.


Our option of a Heritage lock offers a pull escutcheon to the outside and a thumb turn on the inside. The multipoint automatic two hook and centre deadbolt can be operated from the outside by turning the key and is then automatically locked when the door is closed.

Yale Security Guarantee

The Yale Lockmaster and Yale 3 star door locks are approved with Secured by Design, an official UK Police initiative scheme. Yale now offer a Security Guarantee, which in the event of a burglary or break-in taking place at your home due to the failure of a Yale 3 star cylinder lock, Yale will pay you levels of compensation*.

- Up to £250 off any initial call out fee
- Goodwill payment of £1,000 for the inconvenience
- An Anglian replacement door if needed




